# **Project Abstract**

Registration of pre-operative magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and intra-operative ultrasound (US) is essential to neurosurgery, and has been achieved by the MRI/US Team at CAMP. However, the registration of post-resection US with post-operative MRI is also achievable with the novel LC2 technique, but the validation is problematic, as no landmarks have been set by experts. Therefore, a new method for validation needs to be established and implemented.

## Student's Tasks Description

The student will get familiar with the ImFusion Framework for MRI/US and CT/US registration. Furthermore, a state-of-the-art method for deformable single-modal registration needs to be set up with the framework, which will allow the deformable registration of pre- and post-operative

MRI images. The resulting deformation fields allow the transfer of landmarks from pre- to post-operative MRI, and from pre-resection to post-resection US by use of the known MRI relation. After considering the resected areas, the derived landmarks are used for validation of registration of post-resection US with post-operative MRI.
